

## Job Description: Elementary Instructional Coach

#### **Position Overview**

The Elementary Instructional Coach at Summit School serves as a collaborative partner and professional development leader for the elementary teaching team. This role supports instructional excellence, guides teachers in reflective practice, and helps implement research-based strategies across all content areas—including literacy, numeracy, inquiry, and outdoor learning. The ideal candidate is a strong relationship-builder who is passionate about student-centered education and empowering educators.

## **Key Responsibilities**

### **Instructional Support**

- Collaborate with teachers to plan, model, co-teach, and reflect on effective instructional practices
- Support implementation of differentiated instruction and multi-age learning strategies
- Integrate outdoor learning and Forest School pedagogy into classroom instruction
- Assist with curriculum development aligned to Summit's mission and values

#### **Coaching & Professional Development**

- Facilitate individual and team-based coaching cycles rooted in reflective practice
- Provide non-evaluative, supportive feedback to foster teacher growth
- Plan and lead professional development aligned with school-wide goals
- Promote the use of research-based, student-centered instructional methods

- Assist the Head of School and Admissions team with family tours, offering a welcoming and informative experience
